



Pencil Roll Case Pattern

What you will need:

- Snap closure
- Fabric for Pencil Case
- Thicker Interface lining
- Scissors
- Sewing machine
- Needle & Matching Thread



Step 1 - Pencil Case Holders


Fold one piece of the main fabric in half so the decorative side of the fabric is showing.



Step 2

Place this on top of another piece of main fabric on the decorative side, at the bottom half.

PLACE ON TOP 




Step 3

Using the pattern guide lines stitch from the top to the bottom of this folded fabric. Cut off the excess thread.


START AT TOP

STITCH VERTICALLY DOWN



Step 4 - Pencil Case Tab

Place the right sides of the TAB together. On the outside place a layer of lining on top.



Step 5

Stitch around the tab, leaving the left side open. Turn inside out.




Step 6

Place this piece of fabric at the top of the pencil case on the left side.


PLACE ON TOP 

Ensure the open edge of unstitched fabric is on the left. Pin in place.



Step 7

Fold one piece of the main fabric in half so the decorative side of the fabric is showing.



Step 8

Stitch along the left and right edges and then fold inside out so the right side of the fabric is showing.




Step 9

Place this piece of fabric at the top of the case, with the open edge at the top.



Pin in place.


PLACE ON TOP



Step 10

Place this last main fabric piece on top with the right sides facing.


Also place the piece of lining on top.
Pin along the top.

PLACE ON TOP 



Step 11


Stitch along the top of the pencil case. 



Step 12

Fold back the outside layer and take the pins out of the top flap.

Fold the corners in on the top flap in so they don't get caught up when you sew around the outside of the fabric.



Step 13

Fold the outside layer back down and pin in place.


Stitch along the left side, and then along the bottom.



Step 14

Finally, stitch along the right side top, however stop to leave about 6cm gap. Continue stitching the right side bottom.


Cut the very corners off, making sure not to cut through your stitching.



Step 15

Turn the pencil case inside out through the gap.


Iron it all out flat making sure to push out the corners so it sits nicely.



Step 16

Roll the pencil case up completely. How it would look when closed.

Mark on the tab and the outside of your pencil case where your snaps need to go (as shown on the right). Put your snap on the tab and you can also apply the snap on the outside of the pencil case through the gap that is still left open.



Step 16

Hand stitch the remaining opening closed and this completes your roll pencil case.
